

Minutes of A Budget Hearing of the Mayor and City Council of Peru, Nebraska on the 16th of September, 2024 at 6:00 pm.

The Mayor and Council of the City of Peru, Nemaha County, Nebraska, were called to meet at City Hall at 614 5th St, Peru, Nebraska 68421, on the 16th of September, 2024 at 6:00 pm, for a Budget Hearing Meeting, open to the general public, advance notice of said regular meeting, the designated method of giving notice, including the agenda for said meeting, or the availability thereof was published in The Nemaha County Herald newspaper on the 12th day of September, 2024.

Mayor Dave Pease called the meeting to order and informed the public of the location of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act. Council members Theresa Westfall, Brent Brown, Katie Novack.

Agenda Item 1 – Roll Call

Present at 6:00 p.m.: Mayor Dave Pease and Councilmembers Theresa Westfall, Katy Novak, and Brent Brown. Upon roll call by the City Clerk, a quorum was declared pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. 17-105.

Agenda Item 2 – Recognition of Visitors

Mayor Dave Pease informed the public that a copy of City Resolution #2017-02 Pertaining to Conduct Rules for City Council Meetings may be requested from the City Clerk, and read aloud by Councilmember Westfall. There were 3 visitors present.

The budget hearing was opened at 6:01 p.m. Three copies of the proposed budget were available to the public.

H. Pemberton made a presentation outlining the key provisions of the proposed budget statement, including, but not limited to, a comparison with the prior year's budget.

The floor was then opened for public comment on the proposed budget statement. Public comment ensued. All members of the public wishing to address the governing body were provided a reasonable amount of time to do so.

Motion by Westfall and seconded by Novak to close the budget hearing. Upon roll call vote for approval: 3 AYES, 0 NAYS. The following voted AYE: Novak, Westfall, and Brown. The following voted NAY: None. Motion: Carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Westfall and seconded by Novak to adjourn the budget hearing.
