

# PERU FLOOD RESPONSE REPORT

September 6, 2019

In an effort to improve timely communication between the City of Peru and its community members, the following provides updates on several important flood response concerns and comes to you from Mayor Darrin Reeves:

- **Portable Water Plant** – While the portable plant can meet the needs of the community, The remember to practice conservation efforts, which helps tremendously. Thank you for your cooperation as this will allow us to continue to provide good water to the Peru community.
- **Volunteers Needed** – Dumpsters have been delivered to the north end of town. Volunteers are needed for clean-up. Please contact the City Office if you are willing to assist.
- **The City is working with FEMA on projects that will provide funding for the following:**
  - Wastewater Treatment Lagoons
  - Portable Water Treatment Plant
  - Olive Street Bridge – Trailhead and City Compost
  - Debris Removal
  - City Roads

Note: These are important projects as the City of Peru plans for long-term recovery.

- **Community Meals & Flood Supply Distribution** – Peru Community Impact Group (PCIG) will continue to offer free community meals at City Hall on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays of the month, 5:00-7:00 p.m. Flood supply distribution will also continue on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays, while supplies last.
